Subsequently, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest University entered into a collaboration agreement which outlines the relationship and responsibilities of each party. As stated in the collaboration agreement, the annual operating budget for the School of Biomedical Engineering and Sciences requires approval by the governing boards of each university.

The 2020-21 recommended budget of \$5,502,822 for Virginia Tech's contribution to the School of Biomedical Engineering and Sciences is shown on the following page.
